

Certificate Of Glass Warranty

Should a TradeFrame NW Ltd double glazed unit fail, due to manufacturer's defect, within 5 years of its time of sale, it will be replaced free of charge, subject to the following conditions.

1.0 LIABILITY

Liability for failure will only be made under the following circumstances: -

1.1 The unit must be stored, handled, installed and Maintained under the recommendations made in BS 6262 'Code of Practice for Glazing Buildings: 1982' and current GGF guidelines.

1.2 The warranty applies only to installation in formal buildings service conditions within the United Kingdom.

1.3 The unit must be seen to have failed due to manufacturing defect

1.4 Reasonable access to inspect an allegedly faulty unit must be afforded to the company prior to de-glazing and throughout the de-glazing process.

2.0 EXCLUSIONS

2.1 The warranty does not cover consequential or loss incurred during the replacement process.

2.2 The warranty does not cover units displaying the natural optical phenomena known as Brewster Fringes.

2.3 This warranty is valid only with proof of purchase presented by the original purchaser.

2.4 Cost of re- glazing or de-glazing.

2.5 The warranty does not cover undrained frames in timber, plastic or aluminium and it is the responsibility of the purchaser to ensure that the frames continue to be drained for the duration of the sealed unit guarantee as failure to do this will result in the warranty being invalid.

2.6 This warranty does not cover any double glazed units which are reported broken, scratched or cracked after delivery or installation.

3.0 WARRANTY

3.1 This warranty is intended to give additional rights to those already enjoyed by any contract of sale or at Common Law.
